Important Instruction to Students regarding Academics

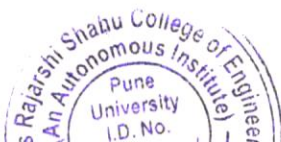

All students hereby informed that the Academic Session for the Semester I of A.Y. 2026-27 will commence from Monday 6th July 2026. Students are expected to follow the rules given below throughout the academic year:

1. Regular academic activities will resume as per time table and attendance will be recorded from day one.
2. Be punctual and attend all lectures, practical, tutorials, and project sessions regularly.
3. As per university norms, maintain the minimum attendance of 75% in theory and 100% attendance in lab sessions. Noncompliance may result in detention for the academic year.
4. If a student is absent for three consecutive days, he/she should take permission of HoD to resume class. If needed his/ her parents will be called for a meeting with HOD if same negligence is observed frequently.
5. If a student wish to participate in any event, he/she should take prior permission from GFM and HoD. Student should submit all event registration details and certificates to GFM. Absent without permission will be treated seriously.
6. Complete and submit assignments, laboratory journals, projects, and other academic work before the given deadlines and get it checked from the respective faculty.
7. Use of mobile phones in lab/ class is strictly prohibited.
8. Circulars/ Instructions of activities initiated from the office of Training and Placement office should be taken seriously. Students should actively participate in these activities in view of their internship and placement.
9. Follow all laboratory safety rules and handle equipment carefully. Any damage due to negligence will be the responsibility of the concerned student(s).
10. Wear your uniform on Monday and Thursday and Identity Card while on campus and maintain proper discipline, respectful behaviour, and cleanliness.
11. Ragging, bullying, harassment, use of abusive language, or damage to Institute property is strictly prohibited and will result in disciplinary action as per Government Norms.
12. Regularly check the ERP Portal and departmental notices for important announcements, examination schedules, and academic updates.
13. Follow all rules, regulations, and instructions issued by the Institute from time to time. Failure to comply may lead to academic or disciplinary action.
