- References: Correctly citing all sources used.

The session then shifted to practical advice on academic writing styles. Prema emphasized the importance of maintaining clarity and precision while avoiding overly complex jargon that could hinder understanding. She encouraged students to focus on logical flow and proper structuring to make their research easily comprehensible.

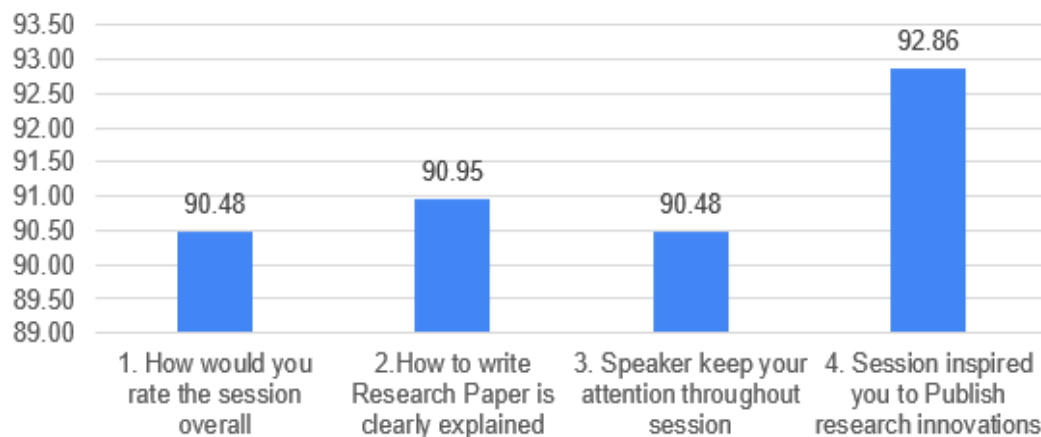
