Course Outcomes (COs) are clearly articulated to ensure alignment between teaching objectives and student learning. COs are developed for each course based on the program's overall objectives and industry requirements. These outcomes are measurable and aligned with POs and Program Educational Objectives (PEOs). The CO attainment process involves defining specific outcomes and mapping assessments accordingly. COs are aggregated to calculate PO attainment, while PSOs are aligned with industry standards and measured through assessments and feedback. The complete process of attainment is documented in the OBE handbook displayed on the institute's website.

The institution regularly evaluates COs, POs, and PSOs to identify areas for improvement in curriculum, teaching methods, and student support services. Feedback from industry experts, alumni, and stakeholders is incorporated to ensure learning outcomes remain relevant to professional needs.
